They had to be U.S.-based, privately held, for profit, and independent—not subsidiaries or divisions of other companies—as of December 31, 2013 (since then, a number of companies on the list have gone public or been acquired). The minimum revenue required for 2010 is \$100,000; the minimum for 2013 is \$2 million. As always, Inc. reserves the right to decline applicants for subjective reasons.
